This volume continues from the Bibliography of East Yorkshire Geology 1948 to 1988 by Mike Horne (*Humberside Geologist* number 9, 1992) and follows the same format. Please refer to the earlier publication for information about the criteria used. It covers publications made after 1988 and some which were missing from the previous bibliography. The term "East Yorkshire" is used loosely to include the County of East Yorkshire (UK) plus the coast of North Yorkshire, parts of North Lincolnshire and adjacent parts of the North Sea; some other articles and publications which are useful to people studying the geology of the area are also included.

I would like to thank David Jutson, John Bateson, Martin Chambers, Mike Taylor (National Museum of Scotland), Nigel Whittington, Stephen Hesselbo (Oxford University) and Wendy Cawthorne (Geological Society) for their help.

Please note that as multi-authorship of papers is becoming increasingly common I have not always entered cross-references for all the co-authors.
